Horsford Benefice of Churches

Parochial Church Councils of: 'All Saints, Horsford'; 'St. Margaret's, Felthorpe'; 'St Mary the Virgin and St Botolph, Hevingham' (Horsford Benefice of Churches).

Our Legacy Policy is to direct legacy gifts towards the following projects:

All Saints Church, Horsford:

- The Organ refurbishment and/or replacement
- Children's Work
- Extending the building and improving facilities available at All Saints
- Re-thatch of the Chancel roof
- Repair to the church guttering
- Accessible entrance and parking
- Music and worship ministry
- Eco Church project

St Margaret's, Felthorpe:

- Tower repair
- Roof repair
- Improving the facilities available at St Margaret's
- Eco Church project

St Mary the Virgin and St Botolph, Hevingham:

- Repairs to the church building
- Enabling the church to remain open for Life Events services (i.e. weddings etc.)

Since needs change over the years, we would encourage you to leave a gift in your will for the 'general purposes' of the parish rather than for a 'restricted purpose'.

We will discuss possible uses of your gift with your executors when the time comes, bearing in mind your known areas of interest in the church (e.g., music, buildings, children and youth, overseas mission or aid) and the church's priorities at the time.

You can be confident that your gift will be used to make a real difference to the parish church to which you have left your gift. We will acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate to. Equally, we can make sure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.
